One-Year-Old Twins Rescued by Divine Providence Home!



At the start of the new year, Divine Providence Home took in one-year-old twins, whom they named Mary and Joseph. The siblings were brought to the home by Ogoja police officers who suspect that the children were victims of child trafficking. Efforts to locate

their parents have been fruitless, thus far, so Divine Providence Home will provide them with a home for as long as needed.

The orphanage has an urgent need. With the addition of Mary and Joseph, and the continuous intake of infants, the nursery has reached its capacity and a second nursery needs to be constructed.

Sister Rita has requested aid in funding a second story addition to the community hall, which will have a large nursery and additional space for the children; otherwise, the orphanage will be unable to take in any additional infants.

Proceeds from our December gala have already paid for the majority of construction, but with this necessary expansion, about \$15,000 in additional funding is needed.

We ask that you please contribute whatever you are able (no amount is too small), so that the sisters can continue their ministry of sheltering babies like Mary and Joseph who are brought to them in need of a safe home.
