Established in 2017, the Okaja Foundation is a charitable non-profit organization that provides support to Catholic institutions serving orphaned children and children experiencing poverty through the distribution of grants and in-kind donations.

WE SUPPORT TWO CATHOLIC INSTITUTIONS:

Divine Providence Home for orphaned and vulnerable children, through the disbursement of in-kind donations and grants which cover the orphanage's entire operating expense, including the children's medical expenses, school fees/tuition (up to the college level) and staff/caretaker salaries.

Catholic Maternity Hospital, through the distribution of donated infant clothing, diapers, blankets, toys and other essential infant care items.

DIVINE PROVIDENCE HOME

Located in Ogoja, Nigeria, Divine Providence Home (DPH) was established in 2007 by Reverend Sister Mary Rita Abang of the Handmaids of the Holy Child Jesus – a Catholic order under the Sisters of Charity. The home has taken in over 100 children since its founding and is known in the community as a safe haven for orphaned and vulnerable children.

Divine Providence is currently home to over 50 children, ranging from infancy to 19 years of age. Each child's story is different and the sisters have never turn away any child in need of a home, welcoming every child with open, loving arms. They work to help each child overcome their experiences of loss and separation by making them aware of Christ's love for them and instilling them with a strong Catholic faith.

CATHOLIC MATERNITY HOSPITAL

When Catholic Maternity Hospital was founded in 1946. The hospital's primary purpose was to provide medical care to victims of leprosy, tuberculosis, and other related diseases. Among several of these patients were their pregnant wives who required immediate attention. Therefore, the Medical Missionaries of Mary (MMM) sisters established a maternity unit.

In addition to services for pregnant women, Catholic Maternity Hospital provides secondary medical services to adult, pediatric, and HIV patients. The area's impoverished are often turned away by other hospitals when ill, due to their inability to pay. Thankfully, CMH offers medical services for free or for very little cost, because everyone deserves access to proper healthcare.



HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2023

We would like to highlight six noteworthy accomplishments of 2023, which were all made possible because of your prayers and generosity:

- **1. The doors of Divine Providence Home remained open** and operational throughout 2023, even amidst the nation's cash crisis, enabling them to shelter six additional children who needed a home.
- 2. Funded the **construction of Divine Providence Home's new housing unit** which will increase the home's ability to take in additional children.
- 3. Awarded Divine Providence with an operating grant, enabling them to pay for the tuition/school fees of every child at the orphanage, including four young adults who graduated from university and one from trade school!
- 4. Sent an in-kind donation of over **600 lbs of clothing, diapers and other children's essentials**, which were distributed to the children at Catholic Maternity Hospital and Divine Providence Home.
- 5. **Funded much-needed repairs to the home**, making the orphanage safer and more comfortable for the children and sisters.
- 6. Thanks to the generosity of our 2023 gala attendees, we were able to launch our **Food and Formula Program** (see next page for more information).



FOOD AND FORMULA PROGRAM

As part of our newly launched Food and Formula Program, we are providing Divine Providence Home with additional funding to feed malnourished babies seeking treatment at Catholic Maternity Hospital, impoverished children at the nearby leprosy clinic and other hungry children in areas surrounding the orphanage.

At the moment, Divine Providence Home is distributing food and formula and/or milk to 13 families on a regular basis - feeding a combined total of 26 children.

We pray that by God's grace and with your support, that number will continue to increase.








